- "Marco \_\_\_\_\_" → we had a pool growing up → I was reminded of MARCO POLO last week...
- Lost my glasses a week ago Thursday → in the shoe warehouse I learned how important my eyes are
- In the Church our 'eyes' should not be our 'focus' → A different kind of 'I' → an 'I Me My' mentality

## Acts 4.32 → When the church is missing an 'I'... We love people instead of possessions

E: Shared everything: Not Communism per se BUT they didn't regard their belongings as holy - stuff not sacred

I: 1st & 2nd Commandment (**LUTHER**: keep those & the other 8 follow) "common" → "not holy"

A: Do you put anything above time with the Body of Christ? - TV, Sports, Yard, House, Personal Time?

\* MOVE FROM "I" TO "WE"

## Acts 4.33 → When the church is missing an 'I'... We share salvation instead of seeking our self-interests

E: The Great Power if from **v.31** = H.S. // Jesus' work is our focus – Grace = "a gift expecting nothing in return"

I: **Ephesians 2:8-9** not "do or don't do" it's embracing grace together

A: When someone comes to church, do we ask ourselves "am I 'better' than them???" - U can't change anyone...

\* MOVE FROM "WE" TO "THEY"

Don O'Neal affirmed quote: "The church is the only organization that exists for it's nonmembers"

## Acts 4.34-35 When the church is missing an 'I'... We give instead of being greedy

E: They gave without any thought of self. Why do I find it hard to give 10%? - Beth & I do (not legalistic Matt. 5)

I: Pharisees tithed but neglected: justice, mercy, & faithfulness / Love of God → Matthew 23:23 / Luke 11:42

A: If we all gave 10% we could quadruple our annual operating budget

"I can't give because I have... a house payment, car payment, this that I want... I, I, I, I" - "I"s have it!

## Acts 4.36-37

When the church is missing an 'I'... We are known for encouragement instead of our ego

E: He had a great pedigree and his actions were admirable BUT he was known for his encouragement

I: Matthew 20:(20ff)25-28 / Philippians 2:1-5  $\rightarrow$  1st Class upgrade then Bill Gates gets on the plane

A: Are you sitting in "1st Class" or are you a part of the "crew?" – where are you serving?  $\leftarrow$  (come back)

**BELIEVE:** not about "dos or don'ts" it's who's family are you in – have you been "born again" **John 3** 

Baptism is the first step of obedience – a public picture of you uniting with God's kingdom

**BELONG:** "I don't have to go to church, my faith is private" not what you get out of it, you're committing to us

**BEGIN:** 2Q: Where do you serve? 1 Peter 4:8-10  $\rightarrow$  BODY Are U a member or a severed limb
